Roots to grow so together we flourish.

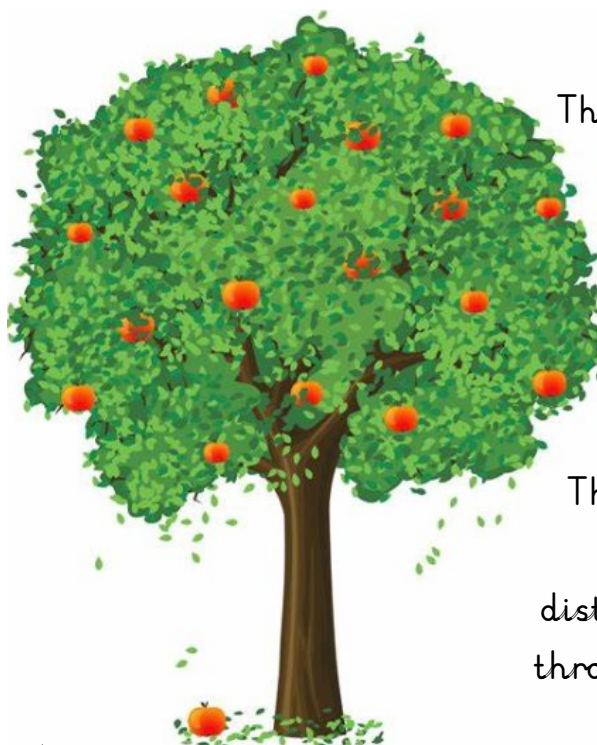

'Rooted and grounded in love.' Ephesians 3:17.

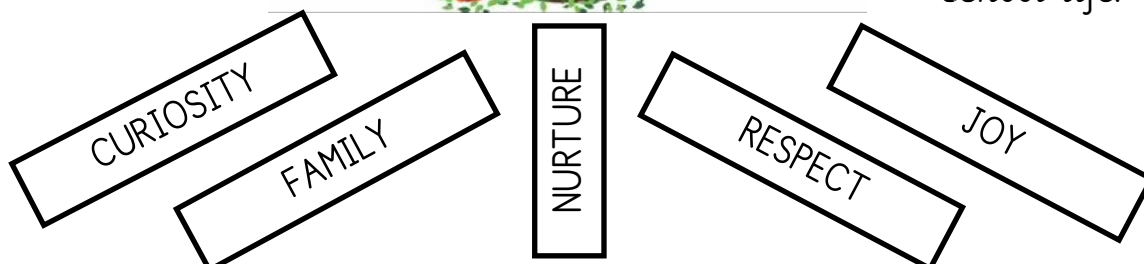
The fruit is the knowledge, skills and attitudes that the children will take with them as they travel through life.
