- We have enjoyed listening to the children share with us what makes them special

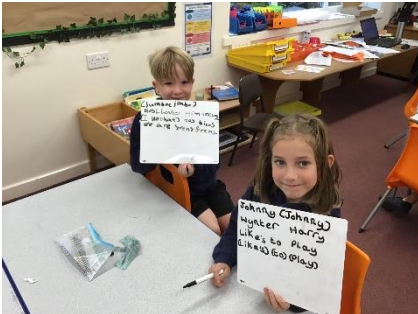
Year 1
