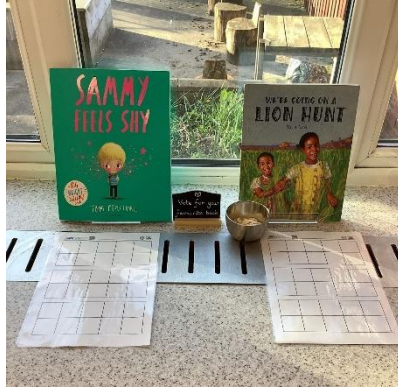

Families are invited to take part in a fun Easter egg trail around Howden. The trail features 10 Easter eggs displayed in participating traders' shop windows. Each egg shows a simple image for children and families to find and record on a trail sheet.

Trail sheets can be collected from Chappelow's Newsagents or downloaded online.

Once completed, trail sheets can be handed in by 12 April to receive a small Easter treat (limited to 400, available on a first-come, first-served basis).
