

In Maths, we continue to work on solving addition and subtraction word problems. We are also working on doubling numbers. We will start to work on multiplication using arrays. We will also work on solving one-step problems using multiplication. We will then move on to division and sharing objects into equal groups. We will also be counting on and back in multiples of two, five and ten. We are also working on writing numbers to 20 in words.

In Design and Technology we will be making our own cards for Mothering Sunday and Easter. We will be using our skills of moving parts and joins.

In History we will be looking at how toys have changed within living memory. We are having a visitor in to talk about the toys she played with when she was just a little bit younger!

In Science we are finding out about 'Materials.' We will investigate which materials would be best chosen for various uses e.g. which material is best used for an umbrella. We will also be having a Science Lab experience where we will don our lab coats and carry out a range of different science investigations.

In English we are learning about toys, both old and new. We will be asking questions of someone older than ourselves to find out more information. We will also be writing various facts that we have found out. We will then be researching and writing facts about different animals towards the end of the half term.

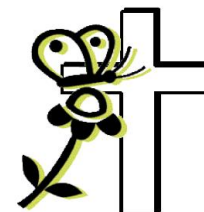
In computing we are copying and pasting images into word documents and then adding text which we are editing for effect. We will be using the internet to find out information and ensuring we follow the school E-safety rules.
