

In Maths, we are working on solving one-step multiplication and division problems. We will be looking at movement, including whole, half, quarter and three-quarter turns. We will continue to work on counting, reading and writing numbers to 100 and beyond. We will continue counting on and back in multiples of 2, 5 and 10 from different starting points. We are also working on writing all the numbers to twenty in words.

In Art we continue to work on our painting skills. Some of the artists we are looking at are David Hockney and Vincent van Gogh. This will involve some landscape work. We will also be working on developing our pencil and refreshing our painting skills.

In Science we are continuing our work on seasonal changes. Our graphs to show the number of sunny days each month will be concluded and evaluated. Also a final look at how weather effects what we wear will be discussed.

In PE over the summer term, we will be developing our skills in ball sports such as football, tennis and cricket. Hopefully we will have some good weather so that we can get outside for our lessons. So please send trainers or pumps in each week. We will also develop our dance skills ready for the summer production.

In English we are continuing to do our fact writing - looking at a range of animals that we have researched. We will also be fact writing based on our History topic of Monarchs. We will be writing a story about under the sea - based on 'Rainbow Fish'. We will continue our focus on phonics throughout the half term and assessing our knowledge.

In computing, we will be using the internet to find out information and ensuring we follow the school esafety rules. We will continue our basic programming and writing algorithms and debugging errors using www.purplemash.co.uk.

In RE our theme is 'Worship and Festivals. We have looked at different Christian celebrations over the year; spending lots of time at the Minster and learning about the Christian faith. Following our introduction to the Islam faith we will learn more about how Muslims worship so we can compare the different faiths.

In Music we will be composing our own short pieces of music and using different symbols to make a simple score.

We will be using a variety of percussion instruments to make our group compositions.

In PSHE, using our Jigsaw resources we will be thinking about Changes will change, may change or won't change. We will be looking at one of the main changes: transition and how we can prepare for this move to Year Two.

In History, we are learning about Kings and Queens, past and present.

We will be finding out about Queen Elizabeth II, Queen Victoria and King Henry VIII. We will be looking at facts about the monarchs, looking at their family tree and finding out about their lifestyles.
